



Cafe Space Standards

The cafe space is open and available for use on days when the cafe is closed. Our goal is that all people feel welcome in this space even though it is not attended by staff. For that reason, we expect people to follow these standards while using the space:

- The space is for personal use. It is not for commercial endeavors (e.g., selling a product), political events for an individual candidate, or any kind of performances or workshops.
- The space can be used by groups or individuals. It is not to be used for meetings open to the general public and meetings generally should not be advertised to the public; however, it can be used by private groups for small gatherings.
- Disruptions and noise should be kept to a minimum. Of course, it is fine for people to converse and socialize; however, we also expect people to respect the needs of others in the room.
- Anyone under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- All tables, chairs, and other items should be returned to their original locations. We don't mind people moving furniture around as long as it goes back to its proper spot.
- All items need to be cleaned or tidied up – for example, if you eat your lunch, please use the compost bin, recycle your paper dishes, and clean your table. Also please take all of your personal belongings with you when you go.
- All areas behind the counter and in the kitchen are not available for use. Please refrain from entering them.
- Only food from the co-op is allowed in the space. No alcohol at any time.
- If you need anything, please ask the staff person in the store.

In general, we expect people to respect the cafe space and the other people using it. Staff may ask you to leave immediately if you are not abiding by any of these standards.

We accept donations at the till if you'd like to help keep the space open.
