
CNFC Community Space Rental Policy

The guidelines below apply to member use of the Bakery/Cafe as a community meeting space.

- Co-op members can reserve the building for themselves or a group they belong to, but the member must be present for the duration of the use. The building may not be used for commercial purposes, i.e. to promote or sell a service or product. Groups of all points of view are welcome, other than those in direct conflict with the Co-op's Mission and Values. The cafe also needs to be cleaned/tidied according to the cleaning list provided at rental.
- Renters are encouraged to carpool or walk to events during Co-Op hours so as to not interfere with parking for Co-Op patrons. Limited parking spaces are available on the Charlotte Rd. side of the building or in the far parking lot facing Sutil Point Rd.
- The kitchen (including dishes and utensils) is not available for use, however the refrigerator and sink behind the counter may be used during rental.
- The cafe is available for rental at the rate of \$20/hour for 20 persons or less and an added premium for gatherings of more than 20 people. Certain exceptions/amendments can be made to this in order to ensure that the space is accessible to all Co-Op members.
- Coffee and tea service is available at the rate of \$1.00 per person. Cookies and snacks can also be made available at various prices (e.g.: 12 cookies for \$10).

The following are examples of acceptable use:

- Meetings of the staff, volunteers or board of directors of non-profits or community action groups
- Birthday parties or baby showers
- Meditation groups, support groups, study groups
- Class presentations
